Detailed Guidelines / Instructions for the Participants

All team members are advised to read the complete guidelines thoroughly for the active participation in the event.

Registration

- 1) Each team would comprise of up to maximum of 4 members including the team leader. All team members should be from the same Institute.
- 2) Teams may have one faculty mentor from their parent institute.
- 3) Team members CANNOT be associated with more than one team. Any such attempt will lead to disqualification of the teams.
- 4) Student teams will not be allowed to add or delete any new participants in the team after the registration.
- 5) Team to select most appropriate problem statement(s) out of the given themes and prepare structured idea document(s) for presentation and submission.
- 6) Teams are also encouraged to think out-of-the-box and provide creative solutions to themes.

- 8) Eligibility criteria and details which shall be checked by the registration teams before allotment of a Team No.
- 9) Team ID will be mailed to the Team Leader of the project by 01st February, 2022. All the further correspondence will be held using this Team ID.
- 10) All team members should be available during 1st February to 5th February, 2022 for the evaluation purpose.
- 11) Team members should be ready with their Zoom and Google Meet platform.

Evaluation

- 12) If there is a tie between two or more teams, the final decision of the prize money distribution will be taken by panel of judges.
- 13) The evaluation will be conducted by panel of Judges and the judgment will be solely based on the evaluation rubrics.
- 14) Evaluation criteria will include novelty of idea, complexity, clarity and details in prescribed format, feasibility, practicability, sustainability, scale of impact, user experience, potential for future work progression etc.
- 15) It is strongly recommended that the teams must focus on submission of quality solutions with well thought approach to stated problem(s).
- 16) The Idea document PPT for a team must be in 5 slides, format and converted into a PDF **(For 01st February only)**
 - a. The first slide will include –Team number, Name of team Leader, name of team members and Institution Name/Affiliation.
 - b. The second and third slide will include – Problem Statement, Description of Your Idea, Solution, Prototype, and Description of the Technology.
 - c. The fourth slide will include – Description of Your Use Cases/Applicability.
 - d. Any other information related to proposed solution.
- 17) **For progressive assessment (02nd February onwards)** each team will demonstrate their project work along with their PPT presentation.
- 18) It is mandatory for all the participants to be formally dressed and keep their cameras ON throughout during all their evaluations. Suitable action may be taken by the evaluation teams in case the teams do not connect properly or found using help from others outside the team.
- 19) Only the registered teams will be allowed to present the mentioned problem statements to the panel of judges.
- 20) The mentors may attend the evaluation, but the presentation shall be done by the participants only which shall be recorded.
- 21) All Participants including mentor should have their valid Institutional ID card/ Bonafide letter displayed during the video call for evaluation.

- 22) E-certificate will be provided to all participants of the team if they attend all evaluations.
- 23) Faculty mentors shall be felicitated with certificate of appreciation.
- 24) The time of evaluation shall be from **11:00 a.m. to 04:00 p.m.** on each day of evaluation. The final timings shall be informed through email on a daily basis.
- 25) The decision of judges will be final and binding on all teams. In case of any issues with the evaluation, teams can appeal to the jury.

23. Shortlisted teams shall be informed by **11:00 a.m.** on **04th February**. Teams who do not receive their short list information may consider themselves as eliminated. They may appeal to the jury if desired.
24. All teams will receive an email by **11:00 a.m.** every day to inform them of their timing of evaluation.
25. Teams who fail to appear on the online platform at the appointed time may be allotted zero by the evaluation team. No representation of any kind will be accepted for nonappearance at the given time of evaluation.
